

Winnebago County indicators tracked quarterly




BadgerCare Plus adult and child participation in Winnebago County, tracked quarterly.

Snapshot: Since December 2009, state enrollment rate has steadily declined, whereas the enrollment trend in Winnebago County has stabilized.



Food Stamp and Food Share program participation in Winnebago County compared to Wisconsin, tracked quarterly.

Snapshot: After a noticeable spike in program expenditures between March and April of 2009, Winnebago County expenditures generally stabilized soon thereafter whereas the state figures continued an upward trend.



Home sales in Winnebago County compared to Milwaukee and Dane counties, tracked quarterly.

Snapshot: Since January 2008, the average home sales percentages were 0.20 percent, 0.18 percent and 0.25 percent for Winnebago, Milwaukee and Dane counties, respectively.



Unemployment rate in Winnebago County as compared to Wisconsin, tracked quarterly.

Snapshot: On average, Winnebago County rates were o.8 points lower between January 2008 and September 2010. Additionally, the unemployment rates in Winnebago County were much below the state numbers in 2009 than 2008.




W-2 programs provide a variety of resources to help Wisconsin residents find and maintain employment. Snapshot: W-2 participation in Winnebago County has increased steadily since September 2009. However, Winnebago County still remains below the state participation rate, and county enrollment appears to be decreasing since July 2010.







Winnebago County indicators tracked annually




Number of **property crimes and violent crimes** in Winnebago County, tracked annually.

Snapshot: Winnebago County's crime rate is significantly below the state level, suggesting that it is a relatively attractive place to live, work, vacation and raise a family.




Median home prices in Winnebago County as compared to Dane and Milwaukee counties, tracked annually.

Snapshot: Between 2005 and 2010, Winnebago County home prices were, on average, \$21,301 less than Milwaukee County home prices and \$86,212 less than Dane County prices.




Median family income for Winnebago County as compared to Wisconsin, tracked annually.

Snapshot: Between 2005 and 2009, nominal median family income in Winnebago County was, on average, \$2,774 higher than Wisconsin's median family income. Between 2005 and 2008, nominal incomes increased at county and state levels.



High school graduation rate in Winnebago County, tracked annually.

Snapshot: Winnebago consistently has higher graduation rates than Wisconsin as a whole. Between 2005 and 2009, the graduate rate in Winnebago County was, on average, 92.7 percent. Wisconsin's figure for the same time frame was 89.22 percent.



WKCE (Wisconsin Knowledge and Concepts Examination) scores for fifth graders in Winnebago County showing proficiency in reading and mathematics, tracked annually.

Snapshot: On average, from 2005 to 2009, 84 percent of fifth graders in Winnebago County received a proficient or advanced *reading score*.

Snapshot: On average, from 2005 to 2009, 79 percent of fifth graders in Winnebago County received a proficient or advanced *math score*.
